- 3. If you fail to comply with 1. or 2. above, it will be a breach of the Council's Code of Conduct.
- 4. The headings to the form are provided for ease of reference and do not affect the interpretation of the paragraphs.
- 5. The completed form will be made available by the Council for inspection by the public.
- 6. You should ensure that you have a copy of the completed form so that you can check its contents when you are considering the agenda for a meeting you are attending and decide whether or not you need to declare a personal or prejudicial interest at the meeting.
- 7. Please complete the form in black ink by writing in capital letters, or by typing your responses.
- 8. Paragraph 4 of the form refers to a 'relevant authority'. These words are defined by the Local Government Act 2000 as having the following meaning:-A county council, a county borough council, a district council, a London borough council, a parish council, a community council, the Greater London Authority, the Metropolitan Police Authority, the London Fire and Emergency Planning Authority, the Common Council of the City of London in its capacity as a local authority or police authority, the Council of the Isles of Scilly, a fire and rescue authority constituted by a scheme under section 2 of the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004 or a scheme to which section 4 of that Act applies, a police authority, a joint authority established by Part IV of the Local Government Act 1985, the Broads Authority, or a National Park authority established under section 63 of the Environment Act 1995.
